# CHAIRMAN'S CHAT

Hello and welcome to the April magazine.

On the 7<sup>th</sup> March we were at Vantage Park, Sparkford, our new Headquarters, with many thanks to the Piper family for the excellent facilities they provide for us. Not such a good turnout, probably in part due to the weather, hopefully going forward the numbers will increase, but the Vantage Cafe offers us a really cosy and friendly atmosphere to have a bite to eat, a cup of tea and chat to like-minded friends.

On the 8<sup>th</sup> March Joan and Chris Jones organised a Sunday Lunch at the Lamb and Lark at Limington. Liz and myself weren't able to attend, but I'm told by Chris that everything went off well and everyone enjoyed their meal. Many thanks to Chris and Joan for organising the event.

## The Tyre Squeals Magazine online.

I have heard through various sources that some members are getting increasingly unhappy that they are not getting a hard copy of the magazine. We send out 9 copies per month as hard copies, these are to some of our senior members who do not have an internet connection. The reason behind this is that we don't want them to feel left out with what is going on within the club, so the majority of our members that do have an internet connection get it via an email and they tell me they are happy with this arrangement, but as I say, there seems to be one or two that aren't.

With the rising costs of printing, postage etc. it is not possible that we can send out hard copies of the magazine to all our members and if we did attempt to do this, the membership cost would have to more than double to cover it. Also, the state of the postal service, which I think we can all relate to, is not really fit for purpose, so I cannot see any alternative to what we are already doing. I sometimes print mine at home via my printer in A4 format which costs me around £1.80p per month.

I've also heard, yet again, that we have a substantial amount of money on deposit. This of course is true, but Yeovil Car Club is a limited company and therefore it has to be run as a business. I appreciate we do not try and make a profit, but in the same token we do not want to make a loss. We did make a small loss in 2025 which you will see when you come to the AGM, but this is something that we don't want to repeat year on year. The money held on deposit, like all good businesses, is there for shall we say a rainy day, like 2020 when Covid 19 struck and it cost the club almost £8,000 in free membership and lost revenue. Some members at that time wanted to mothball the club for 12 to 18 months, had your committee agreed to it, Yeovil Car Club wouldn't exist today.

When I took over as Chairman and Paul Vallis as Vice Chairman, the club had £50000 on deposit. As well as the cost of Covid 19, in 2024 we purchased a new Storage Container, which is now an excellent asset for the club and of course the club has updated some of its equipment to keep the club looking fresh, so at this moment in time we have £41,000 in deposit, but I can see no planned expenditure for the near future, apart from where we have to pay in advance to attend different shows. We constantly hear from different members about how we originally received our money on deposit, it wasn't ever put there by one individual, it would always have been a team effort - there is no 'I' in the word Team.

Shortly I am told you will be able to read the Tyre Squeals via our website, again I have heard complaints from one or two that they can't find this or that on our website. I think all our members know we have commissioned a professional Web Designer to build our new website, this is up and running and there will be additions to that site going forward, you can already fill in a Membership Form and send it to the Membership Secretary, Members Cars will also be added along with a host of other things, which seems to be quite exciting.

I've also heard that our membership is going down. Unfortunately, last year we were under the impression that our membership was at a certain level, but on checking our subscription's total for the year and dividing that by the subscription amount we found that our numbers were not as first thought.

I want to assure you the members that I consider we have some fine Officers on the committee and some very fine committee members who all give up their time for free and don't take any money from the club. Therefore, what they do for the club, (i.e. organised runs etc) is done out of their own pocket apart from printing expenses. I hope this explains some of the thoughts of the committee, if anyone would wish to know more about the running of the club, then please either ring me or come to our AGM at Westlands on April 15th.

I'm pleased to say that we are recruiting new members and some of them are under 40, which in many people's eyes are young members, Over the last 10 years YCC has become in my eyes and others, a very friendly and sociable club, yes we have had one or two problems, every club does, our membership now is hopefully on the up and because we emphasise it a club for any car of any age, if members want to take part in anything the club does, if their weekend car is a little under the weather, then as you know we encourage members and non-members to bring their everyday car, you don't have to have a 50, 60 or 70 year old car to be a member of this club. We are what it says on our badge, The Yeovil Car Club.

I apologise for the rant but some things needed to be said.

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## COVER PICTURE CAR - 1999 TVR CHIMERA 400

**This months cover picture car belongs to club members Peter & Valerie Young who share some history & interesting information about it in the following paragraphs;**

We purchased this Chimaera in 2012 as Peter's retirement present, replacing an MG Midget 1500 which was owned for 17 years. We had looked at a number of examples and, through friends, acquired some basic knowledge of the TVR mark, and more importantly some of the potential problems and idiosyncrasies of owning a hand built, low volume British car. This one was tracked down to a previously TVR franchised dealer in Poole and following a cautious test drive, the deal was done.

The thrill of driving this powerful sports car was, and still is, an awesome experience. We use it all year round and for most holidays including ventures to the IOW, Isle of Man and the Channel Islands. We did take a trip to Blackpool (the home of TVR) in 2017 for the 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the first TVR built by Trevor Wilkinson, followed by a drive to the RAF Museum, Cosford for a gathering of around 200+ of some early cars to the last ones built at Blackpool.

Although the sheer performance cannot fully be utilised on the road, we have been able to experience its' true potential with excursions to Henstridge Airfield and the Castle Coombe race circuit.

This car is definitely a keeper.

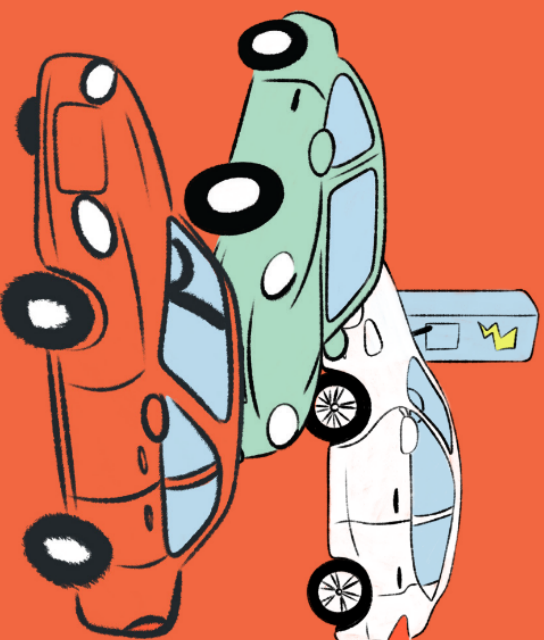
